






Vaccination: WHO (Global data are available for 1980 to 2015 – the DPT3 vaccination was licenced in 1949) Education: OECD for the period 1820 to 1960. IIASA for the time thereafter. Literacy: OECD for the period 1820 to 1990. UNESCO for 2004 and later.

Extreme Poverty: Bourguignon & Morrison (2002) up to 1970 - World Bank 1981 and later (2015 is a projection). Democracy: Politiy IV index (own calcluation of global population share) Colonialism: Wimmer and Min (own calcluation of global population share) Continent: HYDF database

Child mortality: up to 1960 own caluclations based on Gapminder; World Bank thereafter
