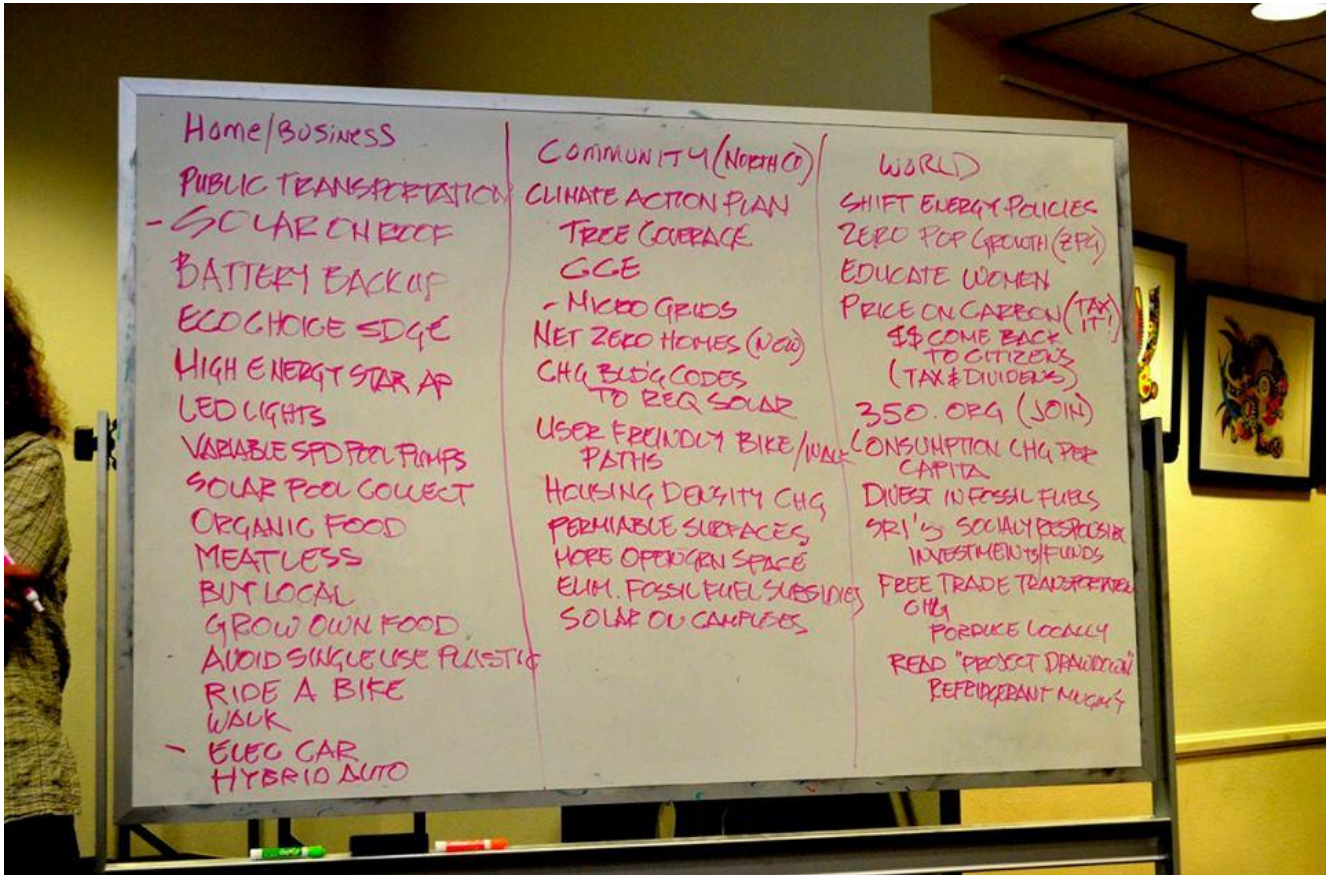


North County Climate Alliance members offered these solutions from their own experiences



What you can do at your Home, Community and in the World:

Home/Business

- Take Public Transportation
- Install a solar roof (with battery back-up)
- Choose 100% Green option with your utility
- Buy Energy Star appliance
- Install LED lights
- Use variable speed pool pump
- Eat organic food
- Go Meatless
- Buy Local
- Grow your own food
- Avoid single use plastic
- Walk or Ride a bike
- Get an electric/hybrid car

Community

- City needs a Climate Action Plan
- Expand Tree coverage
- Start Community Choice Energy
- Develop micro-grids on campuses
- Change building codes to require solar
E.g. net-zero homes
- Create user-friendly bike/walk paths
- Increase housing density
- Create permeable surfaces
- Create more open/green spaces
